## **SC-HART Training For Challenging Rescues**

**CHARLESTON, S.C.** – The South Carolina Helicopter Aquatic Rescue Team (SC-HART) begins their quarterly training exercise today, and it will continue through Thursday.

Pre-scripted daytime exercise scenarios will include marine and helicopter operations utilizing emergency services personnel acting as survivors. The focus of these exercise scenarios will be water search and rescue in-and-around the Stono River and Charleston Harbor.



Training and performance standards for SC-HART members are stricter than anything the military or fire service requires. The team trains together four times a year, and these training exercises are designed to be more difficult, so that the team is fully prepared for real-world missions.

There are more than 30 federal, state, county, and local agencies participating in this training exercise, with St. John's Fire District being the primary local jurisdiction. Agency partnerships are key to the overall success of this quarterly training exercise. Each brings a diverse range of knowledge, skills, and specialized expertise that greatly enhance the learning experience for all team members and participants.

The South Carolina Helicopter Aquatic Rescue Team (SC-HART) is a collaborative effort between the State Urban Search and Rescue Task Force (SC-TF1) under the direction of S.C. LLR, Office of the State Fire Marshal, S.C. Emergency Management Division and the South Carolina Army National Guard Aviation Unit based at McEntire Joint National Guard Base. SC-HART has highly trained professional rescuers, pilots, and crew members that form a cohesive unit capable of performing helicopter rescue using the UH-60 Black Hawk and LUH 72 Lakota. SC-HART has all hazards capabilities, is available 24/7, and responds at no cost (in-state) to the requesting agency.
